| <p>The race organisers shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/competitor, his skipper or crew, as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races. By signing this entry form, participants accept that they are responsible for themselves, their crew, and their boat, whether afloat or ashore. Nothing done by the organisers (ie. the Club, race management team and anyone helping to run the event) will relieve the participants of their responsibilities. By launching (or putting to sea), participants imply the suitability of their boat and the competence of the skipper and crew for the expected or forecast conditions. The provision of patrol craft does not relieve participants of their responsibilities. Neither the establishment of these conditions, their use by the race organisers, nor the inspection of the boat under these conditions in any way limits the absolute responsibility of the owner/competitor. The crew are nonetheless advised to satisfy themselves as to the experience of the skipper and the adequacy of all safety equipment and insurance arrangements.</p> <p>Offshore Races: The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor who must ensure that the boat is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy, and manned by a crew sufficient in number and experience who are physically fit to face bad weather. The owner/competitor must be satisfied as to the soundness of the hull, spars, rigging, sails and all gear. He must ensure that all safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in date and that the crew know where it is kept and how it is to be used.</p> |
